I am sure you are aware in Brandeston of the problems we have been experiencing with the pumping station, situated on land between The Chequers and The Forge.

Following the hearing earlier in the year, when Anglia Water lost their appeal against the Environment Agency to allow discharge consent into the River Deben, we have been in constant communication with AW. Two representatives have agreed to attend our Parish Council meeting in January, to hear the views of residents and to explain their proposals for improving the situation.

It may be that Brandeston folk would wish to attend the meeting, as there may well be implications for your village too.

I will send you an agenda for this meeting (12 January) in the new year.
